

Prayer Guide



PACTS Framework

P - Presence – to prepare for prayer, sit quietly and become aware of God's presence. Say the Jesus prayer - "Lord Jesus Christ, son of God, have mercy on me, a sinner".

A - Adoration – praise God – use worship songs and psalms.

C – Confession – tell God the sins that come to mind and then know yourself forgiven and cleansed by the death and resurrection of Christ and the blood that was shed.

T - Thanksgiving – for all that life brings you.

S – Supplication – intercede for the things that are suggested each week, also other needs that you know of.

Daniel 6–Trusting God

P - Presence

Daniel 6:27a "He delivers and rescues; he works signs and wonders in heaven and on earth,"

A - Adoration

Daniel 6:26b "for he is the living God, enduring forever; his kingdom shall never be destroyed, and his dominion shall be to the end."

C – Confession

Daniel 6:3 "then this Daniel became distinguished above all the other high officials and satraps, because an excellent spirit was in him. And the king planned to set him over the whole kingdom."

When working with others do you always conduct yourself in the way that Daniel did? Confess your failings to our loving God who has provided a way for freedom through Jesus for those who repent.

T - Thanksgiving

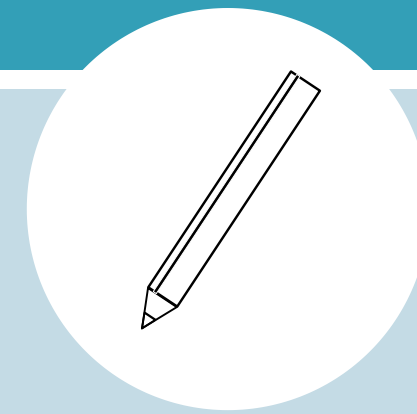
Daniel 6:23 "Then the king was exceedingly glad, and commanded that Daniel be taken up out of the den. So Daniel was taken up out of the den, and no kind of harm was found on him, because he had trusted in his God."

Thank God for those who are obedient to God and by trusting in his word are able to demonstrate that our God is above all other Gods.

S – Supplication

Daniel 6:4b "Then the high officials and the satraps sought to find a ground for complaint against Daniel with regard to the kingdom, but they could find no ground for complaint or any fault, because he was faithful, and no error or fault was found in him."

Ask God to raise up his faithful and trusting servants throughout this time of the Covid pandemic to witness to God in the way that Daniel did – so effectively that unbelieving kings were humbled and turned to the living God.
