

PRAAYER GUIDE



PACTS Framework

P - Presence – to prepare for prayer, sit quietly and become aware of God's presence. Say the Jesus prayer - "Lord Jesus Christ, son of God, have mercy on me". Read the bible passage.

A - Adoration – praise God – use worship songs and psalms.

C – Confession – tell God the sins that come to mind and then know yourself forgiven and cleansed by the death and resurrection of Christ and the blood that was shed.

T - Thanksgiving – for all that life brings you.

S – Supplication – intercede for the things that are suggested each week, also other needs that you know of.

John 21:1-19 Jesus - the miraculous catch of fish.

P – Presence

John 21:4 *Early in the morning, Jesus stood on the shore, but the disciples did not realize that it was Jesus.*

Jesus is always present even though we are not always consciously aware – take time to rest knowing him to be here now.

A - Adoration

John 21:1 *Afterwards Jesus appeared again to his disciples, by the Sea of Galilee.*

C – Confession

John 21:3 *"I'm going out to fish," Simon Peter told them, and they said, "We'll go with you." So they went out and got into the boat, but that night they caught nothing.*

Are there times that you feel that your efforts to serve God are not producing the fruit that you expected? Take time to lay it back down before the Lord and if you can see you have been working on your own confess this to him and listen for His guidance.

T – Thanksgiving


John 21:6 *He said, "Throw your net on the right side of the boat and you will find some." When they did, they were unable to haul the net in because of the large number of fish.*

When we are guided by Jesus amazing things can happen which in our own strength can be impossible. Give thanks for the provision of abundance in your personal experience but also for global cooperation enabling the rapid development of covid vaccines.

S – Supplication

John 21:12-13 *Jesus said to them, "Come and have breakfast." None of the disciples dared ask him, "Who are you?" They knew it was the Lord. Jesus came, took the bread and gave it to them, and did the same with the fish.*

The resurrected Jesus took care of the disciples in this practical way – take this passage back to the Lord in prayer, lifting those who are lacking the basics of life – food, clean water, shelter and safety from violence to him and ask for his provision.
